MEASLES

We have received the following information from the Community School Nurse:

There has been an increase in confirmed measles cases, with a few clusters, this year. These cases are mainly older children and young adults. There have been outbreaks in a university, several secondary schools and boarding schools. In most cases the strain type is identical to the current outbreak strain in France where there have been over 3000 cases already this year. This outbreak has been associated with clusters in neighbouring countries. The cases are mainly unimmunised although a small number of cases have occurred in individuals who have only had a single dose of MMR vaccine.

If you are planning a trip to Europe this summer it would be wise to ensure that all children and young people have had 2 doses of the MMR vaccine to ensure maximum protection from these diseases.

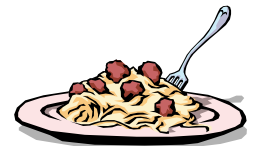

RECIPE OF THE MONTH



TOMATO AND BEAN BOLOGNAISE

SERVES 5

Onion	130g
Celery	10g
Cannellini beans—tinned	120g
Chick peas—tinned	120g
Cooking oil	10ml
Chopped tinned tomatoes	280g
Tomato paste	15g
Dark soy sauce	3ml
Sugar	Pinch
Mixed herbs	Pinch



Chop celery and dice onions.

Rinse and drain beans and chickpeas.

Saute onions for approx 5 mins, add celery and cook for a further 3 mins.

Add rest of ingredients, cover with a little water , stir well, bring to boil.

Simmer gently for 40 mins.

Taste and adjust seasoning and consistency if needed.

This will provide outdoor opportunities to enhance our vibrant curriculum.

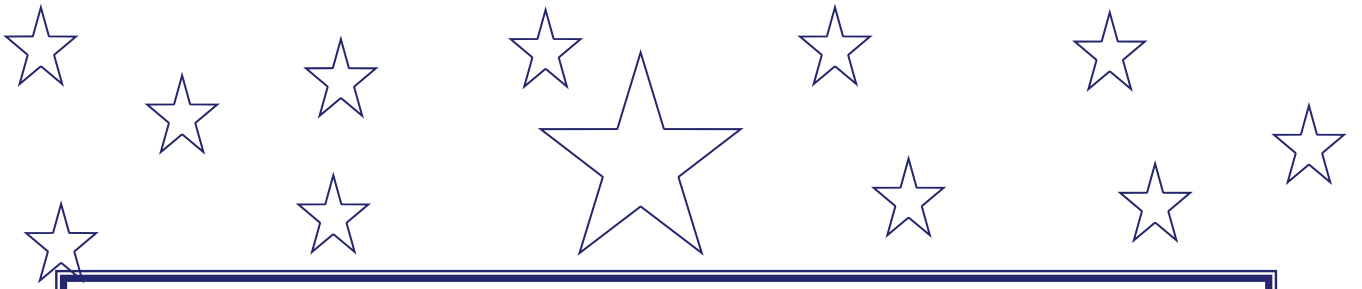

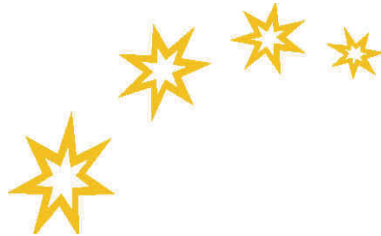

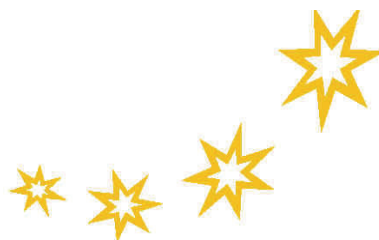
