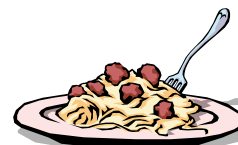

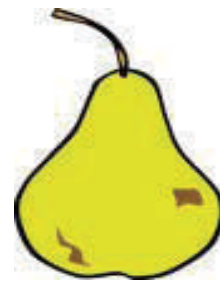

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

PEAR SLICE

Plain Flour	150g
Wholemeal Flour	50g
Margarine	100g
Water	35ml
Pear Halves in Juice	500g
Margarine	100g
Sugar	100g
Egg	1
Semolina	100g
Plain Flour	100g
Baking Powder	14g



PASTRY—Rub fat into flour, add chilled water and mix, cover and place in fridge for 30 mins. Roll out pastry and cover base of tart tin.

Drain and roughly chop the pears.

TO MAKE THE TOPPING—Cream margarine and sugar till light and fluffy. Gradually add the egg and mix well.

Fold in the flour, semolina and baking powder.

Carefully add the chopped pears to the mixture.

Spread on top of the pastry, and bake in oven 180 c for approx 40 mins

Having spoken with numerous staff and officials, I can relay to you their pride in what we achieve every time we play football together.

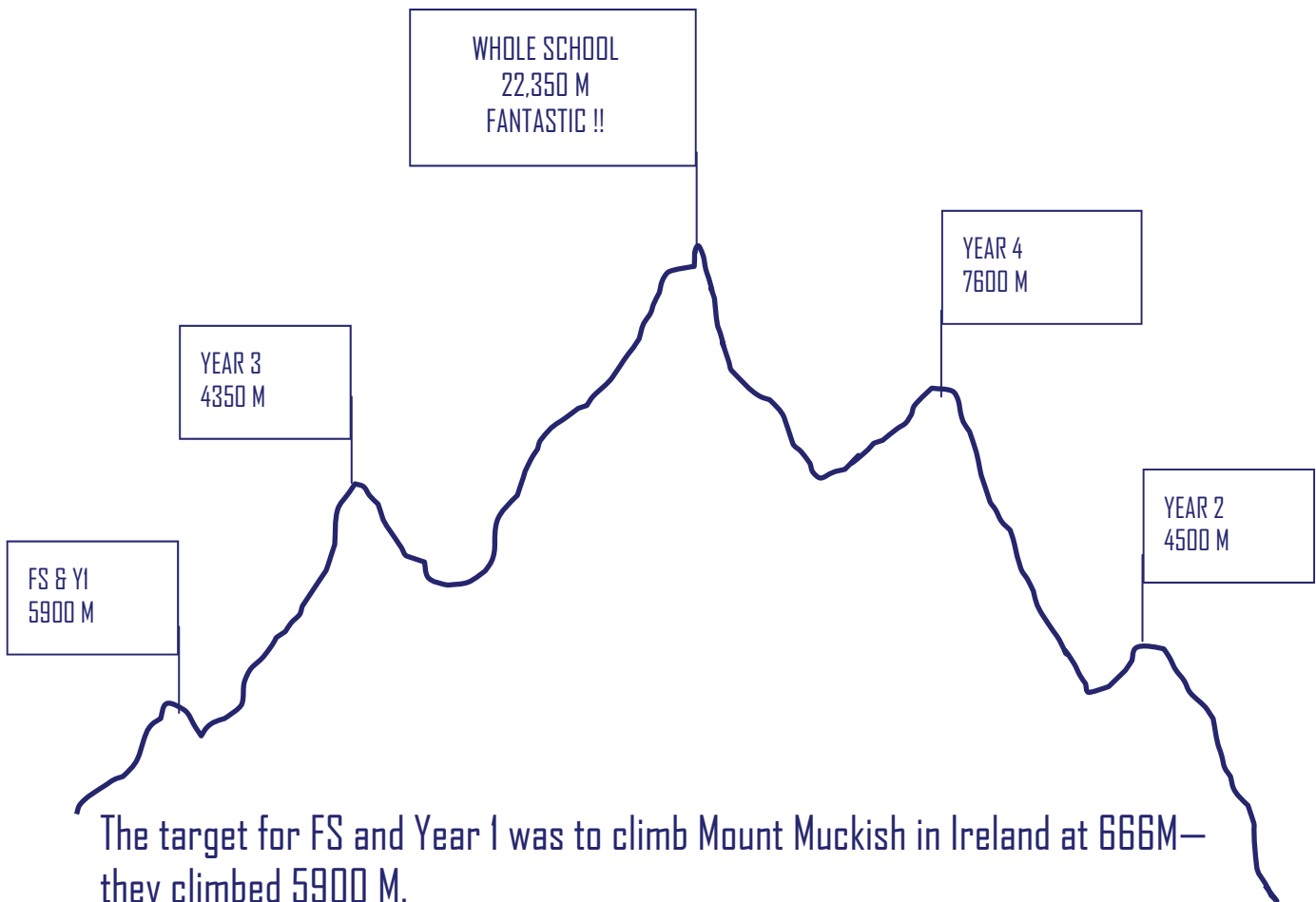
My congratulations must go to our fantastic Year 4 team, who walked away from Kingsmoor with the trophy after some very tense mathematical calculations.

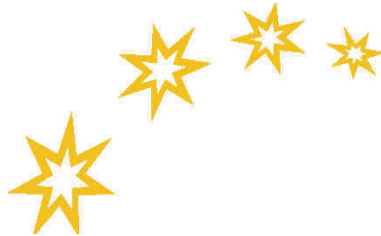

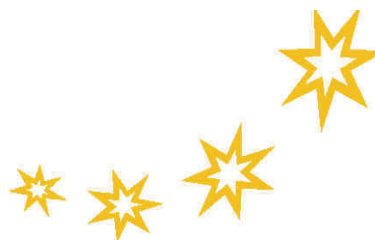
