PARKING IN KINGSMOOR **CLOSE**

We have been sent the following notice from Central Beds Council:

In response to concerns about dangerous and disruptive parking near schools, Central Bedfordshire Council has purchased a new mobile enforcement vehicle which has been equipped with Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) equipment which will allow a Penalty Charge Notice to be issued for vehicles that park on yellow lines.

Whilst the vast majority of motorists are considerate when parking there are still a number of individuals that endanger the safety of others by parking at inappropriate and dangerous locations. Parking restrictions are put in place on safety grounds or to assist the free flow of traffic for the benefit of the residents of Central Bedfordshire and the general public.

The vehicle will operate by collecting the registration numbers of vehicles parked on the restrictions and will process the information to create Penalty Charge Notices. Initially the ANPR van will be used to deal with motorists who continue to ignore parking regulations on school keep clear markings, yellow lines and pedestrian crossings outside the school gates.

This will help to protect pedestrians at entrances to schools and road crossings by improving pedestrian sight lines and increasing their visibility to motorists, which in turn will help with safety when crossing roads.

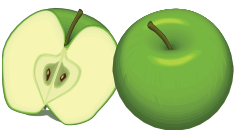
COOKED LUNCHES

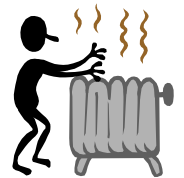
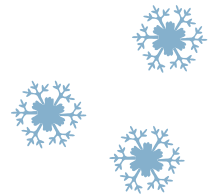
